*Funding Details:**This project has no funding history***Detailed Project Description and Justification:**

This request will allow the Kodiak Soil and Water Conservation District (KSWCD) to establish a robust and user-friendly computer backup system to preserve records and data collected while prosecuting multiple projects related to soil and water conservation. The system is needed to adequately preserve an increasingly computer based record keeping system. Since KSWCD's resources are limited, our support information technological support is limited. This system will automatically backup important data and records as they are generated and safeguard losses of such information during circumstances such as power outages or computer virus outbreaks.

Approximately 1,500 will be used to obtain backup software. Approximately \$1,500 will be used to buy an external data drive and 2 battery backups for existing computers. The remaining approximately \$2,000 will fund approximately 120 hours of time for an IT technician to purchase and install the hardware and software.

Project Timeline:

The initial purchases will be made when funds become available (in August?) The installation work will be accomplished within 3 months of receiving the software and hardware.
