Presently we have automatic doors that are opened by a garage door type opener. Even though this meets the IDEA requirements it does not meet the needs of our school community.

Benefits if Project is Funded

With the present system a teacher or teacher's aide has to open the front doors by using a "garage door opener" to provide entrance or exit from our school. We have two wheel chair bound students. One student is a quadriplegic student and the other wheel chair bound student has cerebral palsy. When one of these students arrive at our school with a parent it is very difficult for the parent to maneuver through our doors. If this grant is not provided the impact will affect the student's safety and wellbeing.
