Detailed Project Description and Justification:

The community of Noorvik needs an additional dumpster to contain trash so that it doesn't get scattered around the community. Additionally, the community needs fencing to enclose the dump area and about 10 pieces of heavy equipment. The fencing will prevent children from playing in the trash, keep them away from the heavy equipment, and prevent vandalism. This will provide for a clean and organized space for the dumpsters and heavy equipment. More importantly, it will keep children out of an unsafe area. Children are currently playing in the trash which may contain harmful objects, toxins, and other potentially hazardous contents. The fencing should also prolong the life of the heavy equipment since it will not be open to the public and any potential vandalism. Operational heavy equipment is important in rural communities since the heavy equipment is used to provide basic community services such as snow removal and water and sewer system maintenance and repair. Additionally, the heavy equipment is used to keep roads open that maintain access to food, fuel, and airport access which often provides the only access to medical care and emergency relief in a crisis. This funding request fills a life, health and safety issue for Noorvik.

Project Timeline:

The trash dumpster and fencing will be purchased in the Spring of 2013 and installed in the summer.

NOWTHEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED: the Noorvik City Council endorses the following priority list of needed Capital Projects in order of funding levels and importance.


Funding level one (50K – 250K): Dumpster and Equipment fencing.

Yes it does. There is a lot of trash dumped by the residents of Noorvik, at the dumpster site, which is not a dumping site. Trash is accumulating and getting scattered. Kids play and vandalize our heavy equipment.

At the dumpsters, which are five or six, the fence will encircle them, including enough room for a dump truck to maneuver there to take them back in and out for delivery to the landfill. 70% 90% equipment fencing will be for about ten pieces of heavy equipment. 425' of fencing needed.

Dumpster fencing: The trash would be contained in the dumpsters, rather than on the ground and willows. It will be a clean organized place. Safe and healthy.
Equipment fencing: When the heavy equipment is fenced kids will not play and vandalize them. No broken windows and shattered glass. Equipment longevity. Our village residents always need rent heavy equipment for personal reasons, such as grand.

There was a draft design for equipment fencing. We had accumulated some 200' of fencing then. Fencing estimated to be about 425' in all. 100' North side, 200' West side, 100' south side and 25' east side. This fence would encircle circumferencing around the Water & sewer building, Public safety building, fire department and room for about 200 pieces of heavy equipment.

This project would have an input by heavy equipment, fuel and oil, maintenance and supplies etc. No funds currently for this project, but, willing to apply for some. Having worked with several fencing projects with Algonquin, IRT, ANT, HC, and the City itself, the estimated cost for this fencing project should run about \$100,000.00. Materials, flights, labor and administration cost.
