Project Description and Estimate: The Council of Athabascan Tribal Governments (CATG) is requesting \$100,000 to complete design, preconstruction activities and site preparation for an ambulance garage at the Yukon Flats Health Center in Fort Yukon. CATG will utilize the CIP funding to leverage construction funding in the form of loans or grant funding from various other sources.

It is estimated that the total construction costs for the ambulance garage will be approximately \$400,000 (based on other similar projects in Interior Alaska, Denali Commission/ANTHC estimates). The Yukon Flats Health Center was constructed in 2006-2006 and opened in 2008. An ambulance garage was included in the planning; however, funding for construction was not available.

TITLE: FY 2014 Yukon Flats Health Center Ambulance Garage

- WHEREAS:** The Council of Athabascan Tribal Governments (CATG) is a Tribal consortium authorized by the Athabascan tribes of the Yukon Flats; and,
- WHEREAS:** The purpose of the Council of Athabascan Tribal Governments is to conserve and protect tribal land and other resources; to encourage and support the exercise of tribal powers of self-governance; to aid and support economic development; to promote the general welfare of each member tribe and its respective individual members; and to preserve the Tribe and its Tribal members; and,
- WHEREAS:** There is no ambulance garage located adjacent to the Yukon Flats Health Center; and,
- WHEREAS:** CATG has plans to construct a new ambulance garage located adjacent to the Yukon Flats Health Center; and,
- WHEREAS:** Maintaining the ambulance in good working condition accessible to health care providers is essential for the health and safety of the residents of the community of Fort Yukon; and,

Now Therefore Be It Resolved That: Ben Stevens, Executive Director of the Council of Athabascan Tribal Governments is hereby authorized to negotiate, execute and administer any and all documents and contracts required for granting funds to the Council of Athabascan Tribal Governments (CATG) and manage funds on behalf of this entity, and,

Further Be It Resolved That: Ben Stevens, on behalf of the Council of Athabascan Tribal Governments is authorized to submit an application to the Alaska Legislature Capital Improvement Program for \$100,000 in matching funds to support the construction of a new ambulance garage in Fort Yukon.
