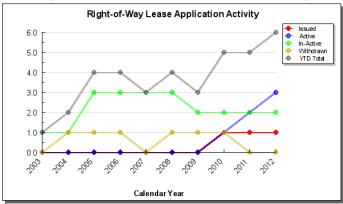
#### **Component: State Pipeline Coordinator's Office**

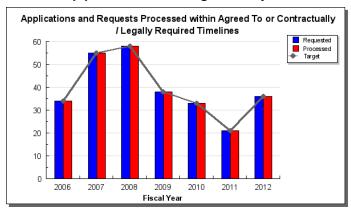
#### **Core Services**

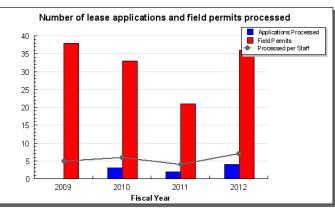

- Administer A.S.38.35 leases including revenue collection, permitting, authorizations, oversight of the construction, operation, maintenance and termination of pipelines and coordination with other state and federal agencies as appropriate.
- Keep the public informed of the State Pipeline Coordinator's Office activities.

#### **Measures by Core Service**

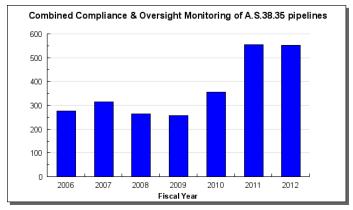
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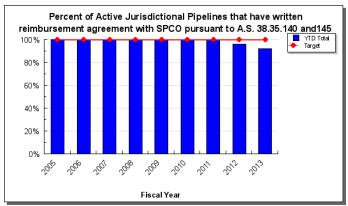
1. Process applications under the Alaska Lands Act and the Right-of-Way Leasing Act and negotiate and deliver pipeline and other right-of-way leases in a manner that serves the State's interests.

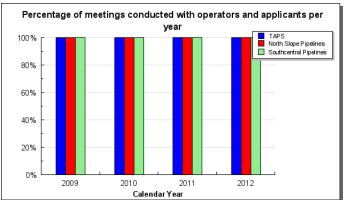




2. Administer A.S.38.35 leases including revenue collection, permitting, authorizations, oversight of the construction, operation, maintenance and termination of pipelines and coordination with other state and federal agencies as appropriate.







Target: Manage issues affecting operations or pipeline integrity in cooperation with members of the Joint Pipeline Office (JPO). The JPO provides the ability to share expertise and clarify potentially overlapping authorities.

3. Keep the public informed of the State Pipeline Coordinator's Office activities.

Target: Allow public to easily view all 38.35 Leases, SPCO regulations, summaries of SPCO activities, and annual reports that address the operating and compliance status of all 38.35 pipelines on the SPCO website. Target: Produce and issue a comprehensive SPCO Annual Report.

### **Major Component Accomplishments in 2012**

Even though the state issued its right of way lease for the Alaska Gasline Development Corporation (AGDC) in March 2011, the State Pipeline Coordinator's Office (SPCO) continues to work with the Bureau of Land Management (BLM) and AGDC in support of efforts to have a federal grant for the AGDC pipeline issued in 2012.

- Continued to review right-of-way lease applications for pipeline projects. In addition, continued to issue amendments, operational permits, and associated documentation within timelines negotiated with the applicant/lessee, or as legally or contractually required.
- Continued to support engineering review for Electronic Automation project efforts related to Pump Station #1
  of the Trans Alaska Pipeline System.
- Issued the SPCO Annual Report in October 2012. The annual report summarizes agency compliance and lease administration activities for jurisdictional pipelines. In addition, the report provides a detailed summary of SPCO FY 2012 activities and accomplishments.
- Entered into reimbursable service agreements (RSA) for proposed pipelines with Polar LNG, Donlin Gold, and Spectrum. Expect to have RSAs with Cook Inlet Energy and Flint Hills before year end.

#### **Key Component Challenges**

- Maintaining an adequate workforce to deliver essential services, with the increasing number of leases and
  lease applications is a key challenge. This includes, but is not limited to, processing lease applications,
  assessment of pipeline right-of-way lease compliance and lease administration, engineering reviews,
  reimbursable services agreement administration, administrative and clerical services. Management
  challenges arise for prioritizing essential services as new projects develop without increasing the number of
  staff. Management strives to ensure a balance of services between new and existing projects.
- Monitoring of the Trans-Alaska Pipeline System given the changes associated with strategic reconfiguration, and declining throughput. These changes include increased automation and reduced Alyeska staffing levels in the field.
- Ensure adequate communication and coordination of pipeline leasing, permitting and oversight with other state and federal authorities. Specifically, ensure adequate coordination of all the potential gas pipeline projects with other state and federal authorities. Potential gas pipeline projects include Alaska Gasline Inducement Act (AGIA) Pipeline Project, Donlin Gold Gas Pipeline, Point Thomson Pipeline, the Polar Liquefied Natural Gas (LNG) project, the Spectrum LNG project, and the Flint Hills project.
- Through regulatory and lease compliance oversight, reduce the likelihood of pipeline shutdowns and environmental hazards due to corrosion and other factors.

#### Significant Changes in Results to be Delivered in FY2014

- The State Pipeline Coordinator's Office (SPCO) will maintain an acceptable turnaround time for review and issuance of pipeline right-of-way amendments and operational permits for established leases.
- Maintain SPCO support of multiple oil and natural gas pipeline right-of-way leasing applications and activities.
- Continue to explore opportunities to work with other state agencies in order to increase the efficacy of SPCO regulatory and lease compliance monitoring efforts associated with AS 38.35 pipelines which are not part of the Trans-Alaska Pipeline System.
- SPCO will administer reimbursable service agreements with all new and existing applicants, as well as with all cooperating state agencies.
