Major Component Accomplishments in 2012

- Continued to meet the demand for certified and native seed.
- The North Laditude Plant Material Center (PMC) provided new native species to the producers thereby increasing the variety of material available to commercial growers and expanding the market for their products.
- The PMC has become a leader in germplasm acquisition in the high latitude regions.
- The PMC has increased production on fourteen new pre-certified releases of selected class germplasm for revegetation work throughout the state.
- Activated storm water and soil erosion control research and technology programs.
- Completed second publication Field Guide to Alaska Grasses.
- Provided all the needed seed potato stock for Alaska commercial seed potato producers.
- Produced the Interior Revegetation Guide.
- Produced the second printing of the Alaska Coastal Revegetation and Erosion Control Guide.
- Publish second edition of Field Guide to Alaska Grasses.

Key Component Challenges

- Develop a horticulture program to benefit the industry.
- The Plant Materials Center (PMC) has difficulties recruiting and retaining agronomists. Experienced
 agronomists are not readily available in Alaska and salaries are more competitive in the federal government,
 University and private sector.
- It has been challenging to operate a fully functioning seed farm while staying in compliance with Department of Environmental Conservation regulations with regard to pesticides. The new five year permit will streamline this process.

Significant Changes in Results to be Delivered in FY2014

- Continue to provide the essential services of purity and germination tests, noxious weed seed examinations, tetrazolium testing, and grain moisture testing.
- Continue to provide timely services to those that request information on invasive species and agricultural pests as outlined in strategic plan for invasive weeds.
- Continue to market and develop plant materials for commercial seed production.
- Develop an app version of the Interior Revegetation Guide and Coast Revegetation manual.
