Contribution to Department's Mission

The Public Information Center (PIC) facilitates one-stop public interface for divisions and offices of the Department of Natural Resources (DNR).

Major Component Accomplishments in 2012

- The Public Information Center (PIC) assisted approximately 20,000 customers and receipted over \$25.9 million in revenues during FY2012. Excellence in customer service produces satisfied customers and reflects positively on state government.
- The PIC produced or assisted in distribution of over 126 media releases.
- The PIC assisted in the marketing, implementation, and in-person sales for three new land sales and other continuing sales, each with different rules of participation.
- The Anchorage PIC assisted the Division of Parks & Outdoor Recreation in counting, receipting, and depositing \$275,819 in day use fees for Chugach State Park in FY2012.
- The PIC assisted in developing and maintaining the over 50 DNR web pages and fact sheets that efficiently relay information to the public. The PIC found and implemented improvements to various on-line public services; improving customer service and saving revenue for the Department. The PIC web page received 86,888 unique visitors and 1.8 million hits in FY2012.
- The PIC assumed the duties of processing Public Notices for the Department of Natural Resources (DNR).

Key Component Challenges

- Retaining and training staff to keep abreast of changes in Department of Natural Resources (DNR) personnel and programs in order to maintain excellence in customer service.
- Continuing to improve and expand web-based information and services.
- Meeting the increasing demand to train the public in use of changing and increasingly complex mapping and data systems.
