Component: Fire Suppression Activity

Contribution to Department's Mission

Managing wildland fires in a safe, efficient and cost-effective manner, commensurate with values at risk, on all State, municipal, and private lands, and lands negotiated through agreements.

Major Component Accomplishments in 2012

- Suppressed 95.0% of fires in Critical and Full Management Options at 10 acres or less.
- Minimized the loss of homes due to wildland fire to seven structures (one residence and six outbuildings).
- Safely managed 422 fires for over 270,000 acres burned statewide.
- Mobilized and provided jobs to 536 Emergency Firefighters (EFF), resulting in nearly \$2 million in EFF wages.
- Mobilized nearly 400 personnel and 31 crews to the lower 48 to supplement the national firefighting workforce. This provided extended employment to nearly 700 Alaskans.
- Contributed significantly to Alaska's economy, impacting more than 425 vendors, personnel salaries for more than 1,000 firefighters, salaries on Type 1 & 2 crews, and local purchases in many communities.
- Managed a large fire near Anderson using the Alaska Incident Management Team.
- Coordinated public, media, and elected official outreach for wildland fire incidents.

Key Component Challenges

- 1. Maintaining firefighting capacity with reduced Federal, State, and Municipal funding.
- Federal grants have funded three elite firefighting crews during recent years. Most of these funding sources have been reduced or eliminated.
- These crews not only provide essential firefighting services, but also provide the training and experience
 opportunities for the future fire managers of the Division.
- The Division of Forestry relies on interagency Federal firefighting support (aircraft, smokejumpers, firefighters) which will become less available due to projected Federal budget reductions of 15-20%.
- 2. Providing aerial firefighting response to wildland/urban interface areas.
- When multiple wildland fires start, initial attack bases cannot deliver firefighters to new fires quickly enough to meet the objective of keeping all fires in these areas to less than ten acres.
- Helicopters continue to be limited in Alaska and expensive to move from the Lower 48.
- 3. Increasing workload as a result of expanding wildland urban interface.
- The population of Alaska increased 10% over the last decade, with many people moving to the Interior of Alaska, therefore increasing public exposure to the threat of wildland fire.
- An increased population increases the risk of human-caused fires in close proximity to residences and businesses.
- Tracking and maintaining an inventory of values at risk requires integration of numerous databases with expanding need for compatibility and accuracy.
- Location of these values and associated logistical difficulties to identify them, mandates such as Federal requirement for 100% Native Allotment protection, and a changing environment all contribute to complexity and multiple resource demands for fire protection.
