Major Component Accomplishments in 2012

- Acquire state land entitlement, defend and plan for use of state land.
 - The state received tentative approval to 36,610 acres and confirmatory patent to 60,732 acres
 - Successfully negotiated remand of Bristol Bay Area plan litigation to the Division for classification determination
 - Prepared and issued public review draft of the Yukon/Tanana Area Plan and began work on East Tanana Area Plan.
 - Received favorable State Supreme Court decision regarding determination of Skagway Municipal Entitlements

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- Received favorable determination from Baseline Committee regarding bay closure line. Reestablished state jurisdiction seaward.
- An adequate amount of state land is transferred into private ownership and to municipalities for settlement, recreation, development and other uses.
 - Progressed in negotiating final entitlement blocks for the newly formed City and Borough of Wrangell, conveyed surveyed Municipal Entitlement for North Slope Borough.
 - o Provided in excess of 1,200 parcels of lands available for sale for private ownership
 - Issued conveyance documents for state land representing 7,313 acres
- Businesses, individuals and other entities obtain authorizations necessary for the environmentally sound use and development of state land and resources
 - o Provided Early Entry Authorization for the Alaska Railroad Corporation for northern extension
 - Eliminated backlog of unissued routine survey instructions and reduced turn-around time from 6 month to 2 months
 - Reduced authorization backlog by 34.3%
 - Implementation of Business Process Management programming to provide more efficient and transparent processing of authorization applications.
- All state land is unencumbered by unauthorized use, contamination, or waste that makes it unavailable for other public use and development
 - Began construction of bridge across Healy Creek to access major Abandoned Mine Land reclamation project

Key Component Challenges

- Acquire state land entitlement, defend and plan for use of state land.
 - Review and prioritize for relinquishment of 1.5 million acres of state-selected land
 - Monitor proceedings of federal Baseline Committee for revisions to bay closure line that established point from which three mile limit is measured
 - Complete reclassification decision on Bristol Bay Area Plan request for land reclassification within court designated timeframe
 - o Defend ownership interests through Navigability and RS2477 quiet title action law suits.
- Ensure an adequate amount of state land is transferred into private ownership and to municipalities for settlement, recreation, development and other uses.
 - Increasing Borough restrictions create greater cost and challenge to offer land sales within the boroughs
 - Some boroughs are reaching the end of their entitlements which will result in increased requests for land exchanges and public and charitable conveyances.
 - Prepare Municipal entitlement decision for newly formed Wrangell Borough
 - Work through backlog of defaulted lands sales contracts and prepare relinquished lots for over-the-counter sale
- Businesses, individuals and other entities obtain authorizations necessary for the environmentally sound use and development of state land and resources
 - Continue to identify and eliminate processing inefficiencies that delay issuance of land use authorizations, eliminate backlog of authorizations, and implement new technology to support efficiency measures to prevent future backlog.
 - Ineffective enforcement authorities prolong/prevent appropriate stewardship efforts to provide adequate stewardship on all state lands
 - o Establishing sufficient general permits to reduce authorization processing time
 - Manage workload from litigation consuming significant amount of staff effort
 - Recruiting and retaining technical and professional level staff
- All state land is unencumbered by unauthorized use, contamination, or waste that makes it unavailable for other public use and development
 - Ensuring Bureau of Land Management (BLM) removes trespass structures before conveying land to the state
 - o Increased unauthorized use of state lands cannot be effectively addressed
 - Removal of large hazardous material sites

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Significant Changes in Results to be Delivered in FY2014

There are no significant changes to the deliverable for FY2014. The Division has embarked upon an aggressive project to streamline the land use authorization process and work through the existing backlog. The deliverables outlined in the FY2014 budget will continue to be the focus of the Division. There will be a focus on processing and providing timely, efficient, and predictable authorizations.

The Department of Natural Resources (DNR) requests funding to begin the implementation phase of the Big Game Guide Concession Program by late FY2014.

The Division of Mining, Land and Water (DMLW) has conducted a multiple year effort since 2006 to modify how guide areas are allocated to increase quality of hunts, provide better stewardship of resources, provide an effective means to allow guides to compete for the opportunities, and meet the thresholds established by past court cases. Since that time DNR has hosted 15 public meetings (in person or via web), collected nearly 450 verbal or written comments and attended many other formal and informal meetings and discussions on the topic. It is expected that the regulations to operate this program will be completed by mid FY2014.

Program components are now being developed and made "shelf ready" to prepare for the implementation step. DMLW is currently organizing an effort to write, assess, and finalize the essential program components, including: mapping necessary to communicate opportunities and restrictions to prospective applicants; protocols for the panel that will evaluate competitive offerings to include instructions, scoring criteria, and organizational rules; permitting documents with appropriate stipulations that will become the authorization tool; protocols for monitoring and compliance strategies; application package including instructions and guidance for proper completion; and design of a public outreach effort to help the affected public get through the transition/implementation process. It is anticipated that design, development, and completion of the essential program components necessary for implementation can be completed late in FY2014.

Implementation of the Program

To implement the program statewide, DNR would first put out a call for applications for all of the proposed 300 guide areas. Each of the approximately 570 guides will be able to submit an application for up to three areas (in theory, we could receive up to 1,700 applications this first round). The applications are submittals of detailed information and will contain the applicant's responses to a set of criteria, including a detailed business plan for each guiding operation and all supporting documentation that illustrates a guide's history. These submittals may be extensive depending on the applicant's background. In a recent U. S. Fish and Wildlife Service (USFWS) concession offering, one individual submitted 7,000 pages of material when applying for four areas. The DNR application requirements are very similar to that of the USFWS process.

Once the application period is closed, staff will need to screen each application and prepare it for rating by an evaluation panel. Evaluation panels will include at least one DNR staff per panel and currently it is proposed to have 4 panels with three participants each. The application scoring process will be very time intensive. The scoring for the USFWS 2011 concession offering consisted of 8 evaluation panels of 3 people each scoring 235 applications over three weeks. This resulted in 2,880 man hours for their staff. The GCP application process will repeat every three to four years due to an initial staggered approach to permit term length of 4, 7, and 10 years.

The stagger in permit lengths is designed to create a concession process that revolves on an approximate two year cycle. Each cycle includes the preparation for the offerings, the application submittals and scoring, the notice of awards, and the issuance of concession permits. In between and during each offering, staff will be responsible for all of the additional requirements of the program, including: performing annual monitoring and management of the 300 concession casefiles, annual field inspection and compliance checks, annual scoring of year end reports, fee collection, revenue and billing entry, conflict resolution and the mitigation of non-compliance, and education and outreach for the program. In addition to the direct concession program requirements, staff will be tasked with the adjudication and management of all land use authorizations for camps, cabins, and all supporting infrastructure related to commercial guiding.

Current Request

Nine (9) DMLW positions are required to be funded for six months in the budget year FY2014 in order to begin the implementation phase. Without these positions,
