Major Component Accomplishments in 2012

Maintained compliance with administrative regulations, and federal and state accounting and reporting requirements.

Key Component Challenges

Demands on existing staff to partner with Department of Administration in the development of the new Integrated Resource Information System (IRIS), the Workplace Alaska replacement, the Classification System analysis and replacement, implementation of new internal accounting controls, while continuing to provide outstanding service to our customers, continues to be a challenge.

During FY2012 two human resource (HR) specialists were transferred from the Department of Administration, Division of Personnel and Labor Relations to the Department of Natural Resources (DNR), Administrative Services component, as part of the re-integration of some HR functions back to agencies. The two positions transferred to DNR do not provide adequate staffing levels relative to the HR workload transferred and expected to be performed by these positions. As a result, little or no time is available to provide assistance to departmental staff with workforce development strategy and planning issues which are occurring with increasing frequency. Additionally, the significant increase in recruitment and hiring functions occurring annually due to the seasonal workforce will likely result in excessive overtime and employee burnout.
