Village Safe Water funding for watering point, water/sewer haul system, new Laundrymat, a new sewage lagoon, and a boardwalk project.

Detailed Project Description and Justification:

The Community of Napaskiak is a growing year by year and solid waste such as trash is piling up in our our only dump area: the only heavy equipment the community has is a bulldozer and this makes this makes the operator limited to what the dozer cannot move all solid waste for public access to throw trash away. With a new loader, this can be solved and the loader will be used for snow removal for 4 wheels which hauls water/ sewer to the lagoon built through Village Safe Water funding; it will also be used to clear snow for better access to houses, and public areas such as school and post office. The Village members have hard time trying to move heavy materials such as trailers, boats, and other heavy materials not just for safety but for the safety of our children and youth. With the new loader it will make the Village of Napaskiak a safer place to all residents of Napaskiak.
