Detailed Project Description and Justification:

Nushagak Electric & Telephone Cooperative (NETC) is a member-owned Cooperative which strives to provide reliable electric, telephone, CATV, and internet service to the member/owners in the NETC service area.

The cost of energy in rural Alaska is of great concern to our members and the management team at NETC. Balancing the growing cost of providing power to our members/owners as well as maintaining a healthy financial status is a daily challenge at NETC. We wish to promote economic growth within rural Alaska. We have a capital project scheduled in 2014, which is necessary to provide safe, reliable electric service to our members and provide for todays and future power obligations.

A small Rate Increase was implemented in 2013, to our members. We have also requested approval for an additional 1/2 penny Rate Increase that will help offset the cost of the proposed project.

The Cooperative's current priority is to replace its only substation that was built during 1972. NETC has completed preliminary work for the construction of a new substation and construction will begin in the spring of 2014 with completion in 2015. The estimated cost of this project is \$1,054,135.00.

NETC is seeking support in funding for the substation project scheduled to begin this summer.

This funding will assist NECT in continuing to provide safe, reliable electricity to its members and possibly alleviate the need for additional KWh rate increase in 2014.
