Detailed Project Description and Justification:

The University of Alaska Mining & Petroleum Training Service program in Juneau offers students an opportunity to be educated and trained for work in the mining industry in Alaska. There are classroom components to the training in Juneau that includes the use of a mine simulator. The course also includes field training in a Juneau mine shaft. Currently there is no drill for training purposes and this request would fund the purchase of a refurbished single boom jumbo drill. This is an essential tool used widely in today's mining industry and will greatly enhance the local program. The drill will cost \$120,000 and will be procured by Juneau's UAS training director. It will be used in the Juneau UAS Mine Training program.
