A RESOLUTION OF THE NEWTOK TRADITIONAL COUNCIL ESTABLISHING CAPITAL PROJECT LEGISLATIVE PRIORITIES FOR FISCAL YEAR 2015 AND DIRECTING THE DEVELOPMENT OF A 5 YEAR CAPITAL PROJECTS PRIORITIES FOR THE NEWTOK COMMUNITY

WHEREAS, A duly published hearing was held on September 27, 2013 to obtain public comments on capital improvement projects and legislative priorities; and

WHEREAS, It is the intent of the Newtok Traditional Council to provide the Alaska Governor, the Alaska State Legislature, Alaska State agencies, the Alaska Congressional Delegation, and other potential funding sources with adequate information regarding the Community's capital project funding needs.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, the Newtok Traditional Council directs the Newtok Tribal Administration to develop a 5 year Capital Projects Priorities Plan for the community and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, directs the Tribal Administrator to purse public funds for the following capital improvement projects are identified as priorities for the FY 2015 Alaska State Legislative Request:

Relocation:

1. Newtok/Mertarvik Support: 26' Skiff – Outboard \$60,000
2. Bulk Fuel/Staged Power; Conceptual Design; Design, Permitting \$2,750,000 –Alaska Energy Authority


Public Facilities:


1. Treated Lumber \$125,000 for Critical Public Access/Boardwalk
2. Washeteria; Maintenance & new equipment \$75,000
3. New Water Source: 6000' pipe - Pumps; \$475,000
4. UPC Electrical Grid; \$95,000 – Replacement Transformers, Lighting, Contract Lineman
5. Landfill: Burnbox, Vehicles (ATV, Snow machine – Cart & Sled) \$175,000

Public Safety:

3. \$125,000 Police: Vehicles (Snowmachine/ATV) , Cold Weather Gears, Communications Equipment, 22' Skiff/Outboard Motor
