Detailed Project Description and Justification:

This project is needed to construct an equipment maintenance building at the Central Peninsula Landfill (CPL).

The Kenai Peninsula Borough Solid Waste Department is requesting legislative assistance for the construction of an equipment maintenance building at the CPL.

In the early 1990's, the Kenai Peninsula Borough constructed a facility to support unlined landfill operations. A 1,500 square foot maintenance shop was included in a 16,000 square foot building that was constructed to manage the waste. Due to more stringent State and Federal regulations that required a lined landfill, the Kenai Peninsula voters approved the issuance of \$12,000,000 in bonds in 2003 to support the required transition for an unlined landfill to a lined landfill operations. Approximately \$1,250,000 in bond monies was expended for the purchase of additional heavy equipment to support lined operations. Adequate indoor space is no longer available to maintain costly equipment needed to support the current lined landfill operations.

The proposed building is planned to be 8,000 square-feet (80' X 100') which will include one drive-through bay. There is no office space or break room facility planned as part of this maintenance building.

Timeline: Site development would commence in fall 2014. Project completion is anticipated for Fall 2015.
