Detailed Project Description and Justification:

Residents of the community of Ninilchik support the needed improvements. For more than fifty years the Ninilchik Community Library has played an integral role in our community. The library is a permanent 11-year old building which provides community use for many functions. The library has a collection of over 10,000 books and other materials. It has 6 patron computers which are heavily used. NCL is an active participant in the State Library Association's OWL (Online With Libraries) project. The OWL Service is maturing with more programs available for local community members and school kids.

A comprehensive upgrade to the parking lot includes paving, filling in two areas and substantial ditching to provide water run-off control to direct water and snow melt to the Sterling Highway culvert system.

REQUEST FOR BID

The Ninilchik Community Library is seeking a paving grant via the Kenai Peninsula Borough priorities system. Here are the specifics:

The lot was engineered and built with an appropriate layer of D1 gravel in anticipation of eventual paving, however, some additional D1 will be necessary.

The grading of the lot away from the building itself is adequate although a slight rise occurs about 10 feet from the building which may be smoothed out, or not as the contractor recommends.


The well must be protected from contact with cars driving around in the lot, another post would be effective.

Two areas must be filled in with rock and/or fill to control the runoff from the hillside. Water collects in area which will be directed toward the ditching along the backside of the paved area for eventual discharge into the Sterling Highway culvert system. Care to be taken to not disrupt the mature spruce trees near the auxiliary building. Area to be paved with appropriate slope.

Line 2 indicates approximate position of ditching after paving to direct any runoff South toward the property line for connection with the Sterling Highway culvert system.

Area 1 (outlined in blue) indicates the area to be paved with 2- inches of asphalt paving. Paving to be sub-contracted and coordinated with other paving jobs done in the summer building season. There are 2 access driveways, one to the main library building and the other to the auxiliary building to the south. Special consideration for a handicap parking space to the North of the Arctic Entry and compliance with ADA handicap ramp specifications from the parking space to the entry.
