## **Detailed Project Description and Justification:**

Residents of the southern Kenai Peninsula and the community of Ninilchik support needed improvements, and identify the Fairgrounds as our greatest public use facility. More than 80% of the community activities happen here, to include the Halloween Hoot, the Community Christmas, 9/11 fund-raiser banquet for the Ninilchik Emergency Services, and much more. The community of Ninilchik and the greater Kenai Peninsula rely on this facility for much more than the annual fair.

The Kenai Peninsula Fair has been a huge part of the Kenai Peninsula since inception in 1951. During the 2013 summer season our leach field failed. We currently have two septic systems at the fairgrounds. One that was put in prior to 1979, is of unknown origin, the other was approved by DEC in 1989. With the growth of the fair, neither system is sufficient. We have contacted several contractors for rough estimates of the cost of engineering a new system and replacing the current systems with one combined system. We do not have sufficient funds to make any of these repairs and without them the facility will cease to be functional.

The Community of Ninilchik met on September 25, 2013 and during a vote, conducted by borough representative Brent Johnson, the community agreed that these upgrades to the fairgrounds where the second priority of the community of Ninilchik. They felt the Ninilchik Library was first priority, as they had been requesting paving for a number of years and it was their turn to be first.
