## Principal's Priority

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Replace library chairs purchased when school was opened in 1984 to increase functionality and utility of library. The chairs are approximately 28 years old. The chairs are constructed of a rubberized mesh that creates a seat that is bouncy. The seats are constructed with 4 post legs, which do not glide when pushed in or out. The seat and seat backs on the chairs have wire loops on the ends. These wire loops constantly get caught on clothing (such as belt loops, shoelaces, and pockets).
