#### **Principal's Priority** 2

Ursa Major Elementary is currently looking to upgrade their outdoor/winter education equipment. Most of the cross country skies, ice skates, headgear and cross country ski boots are worn-out and present a safety concern. Currently, Ursa Major has a strong partnership with the JBER command and receive support from Aurora housing and Dyea Nordic ski chalet. Aurora housing has agreed to pay for Alpine services to flood, plow and hot mop a skating rink on the school grounds. Dyea ski chalet has agreed to groom all the trails near the school including a large warm up track in the large field adjacent to the school grounds for Ursa Major students to use for PE classes and the after school ski club. Our ski club has had over 100 students that ski after school several days a week from January to April.

Many Ursa Major students have been raised in southern states and have never been exposed to any winter sports or the many great winter activities that Alaska has to offer. Our school has worked hard to establish a program that lends skate and skies to students and families who are interested to use them on weekends and holidays, but lack the resources. We also have volunteers that come during our recess times during the week to teach and assist with skating lessons.
