Detailed Project Description and Justification:

There is a need for road improvement. There are numerous and potentially hazardous potholes making driving dangerous. The current road system was built in 1982 without much maintenance except for annual snow removal and minor repairs, making dust another hazard to those with upper respiratory conditions. Having this equipment will improve the health of our community members especially for elders and person with respiratory health issues because they will have the opportunity to participate physical activities without the irritation of dust. Improved road condition will also reduce potential vehicle accidents. Drainage corrections will reduce the amount of standing water and help reduce the resulting associate health issues. Through our tribe-Kaltag Tribal council will provide assistance with through the IRR program.

The City has a garage to secure the equipment and protect it from weather, and will be able to maintain the equipment because we have two mechanics on staff.

The Council have identified the need to expand economic opportunities for future growth and development. We have solicited contracts with the Kaltag Tribal Council and State of Alaska Department of Transportation for upcoming construction projects.


