Detailed Project Description and Justification:

These funds would be used to construct two 14'x 18' log and timber cabins. Once completed, they will both be public cabins owned, booked, and maintained by the Division of Parks & Outdoor Recreation.

One cabin is to be constructed in the Courverden Point area, the other in the State Marine Park System, both in the Juneau area. In the past 11 years there have been 5 public use cabins built by T.S.I.

These projects involve many volunteers. Most were local, but some came to work on the project from around the nation. The bulk of the money is for the purchase of Alaska harvested and milled lumber. Some materials are donated or greatly discounted from local merchants.

These cabins have been very successful, once completed they are booked solid. This has resulted in rental income which covers the cost of maintenance within the Southeast region. Plus, the Territorial Sportsmen tries to maintain a public cabin maintenance fund to help when maintenance is a high priority. In addition, these cabins have already been used, as intended, for emergency purposes.

With limited general fund dollars, this kind of volunteer cooperation can make state dollars go a long way and provide for greater public safety while significantly distributing public uses in the region.
