Since 1974, the majority of senior center funding comes from the Older Americans Act and is funneled through either the State or the Tribe. Most of this funding is needed to pay staff who provide nutrition and transportation services for local elders.

Detailed Project Description and Justification:

The current stove/oven is old and does not have enough burners for the quantity of cooking required at the site. The office copier is old and can no longer be repaired, as parts are no longer being carried. The Swan Lake Senior Center in Sitka employs many local staff and serves hundreds of seniors and people with disabilities each year. The demand for photocopying is huge, including monthly report data sheets, timesheets, invoices, applications, driver logs, Participation Registration Forms, food orders, and employment documents. Sitka provides two routes of home delivered meals. The old "heated" brick system was no longer working to keep the volume of meals at a safe temperature. The plug in heated bags are working for Sitka but are expensive. To meet the volume of HDMs two more heat/cold bags are needed. Sitka's dining room chairs are old and are being held together with black duct tape/electrical tape. They are unseemly and must be replaced for the comfort and safety of our elderly clients.

As soon as notice of funding is received, we will order the equipment and supplies, hoping to receive in the summer of 2014.
