Detailed Project Description and Justification:

There are three, closely entwined, parts to this proposed project. First are the student textbooks. At a cost of \$65 per text, it will take \$9,750 to equip each student in six intermediate classrooms with a new textbook. Second are the teacher materials that support the textbooks. At \$950 per grade level, it will cost \$2,850 to supply six teachers with manuals, supplemental materials, and technological support that will help deliver Social Studies instruction to students. Third is a map and globe skills program for fourth grade. Northwood currently has one incomplete set of these materials; it will cost \$1,700 to add a second, full set. The fourth grade teachers will continue to share these materials, but the additional set will allow more students to have the hands on experience.
