This modification will also increase the security of the property and safety of the residents.

Detailed Project Description and Justification:

South Peninsula Haven House is a 24-hour staffed shelter with a mission to support and empower people impacted by domestic violence and sexual assault. As part of the area's comprehensive public safety network, Haven House operates a 10-bed shelter and child advocacy center and has responded to community crisis needs by expanding services. This increased service demand has occurred while the shelter faces dramatic increases in the cost of fuel and utilities.

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These projects will build on sustainability programs that have already been undertaken at Haven House. These include an internal recycling program, replacement of old inefficient plumbing fixtures and windows, and the addition of a greenhouse.
