Detailed Project Description and Justification:

The Salcha Fair Association has 32 acres of land, 16 of that has been developed with a baseball field, a playground, a midway, two pavilions and a parking area. This area has been designated for community use. For the past 20 years the Fairbanks North Star Borough has maintained the ball field, playground and surrounding grounds. With recent budget cuts FNSB is no longer able to maintain those grounds and the maintenance falls to the Salcha Fair Association. They require a utility tractor, two push mower, a storage shed, gas cans, shovels, rakes, hedgers, weed wackers, and funds for fuel.

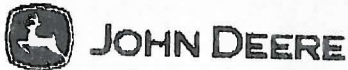

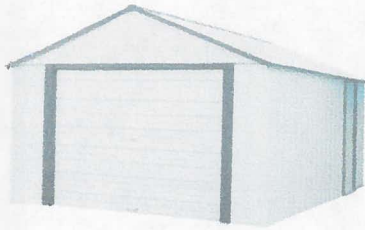

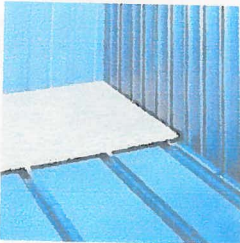

RE: REQUEST FOR A GRANT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$43,136.75 FOR GROUNDS MAINTENANCE OF THE SALCHA FAIR ASSOCIATION'S PROPERTY.

The Salcha Fair Association is requesting a State Legislative Grant to help with the maintenance of the grounds.

The Salcha Fair Association is a 100% volunteer run non-profit organization. We lease our property from the Fairbanks North Star Borough. We have 32 acre's of land, 16 of that has been developed with a baseball field, a playground, a midway, 2 pavilions and parking area. The Borough has designated this property for community use. In the past 20 years plus the FNSB parks and recreation department has maintained the ball field, playground and surrounding grounds. With mowing, fertilizing, fence repair, signs etc. They adopted the playground because we put it in per required specifications that they wanted, in order to have the playground. We were only responsible for the care of the midway and parking area, which was hard enough as it was to get it ready for our annual fair each year, and maintain for year round use. We also have games on the ball field weekly, Birthday Parties in the gazebo on the playground, several celebrations of life in the newly built pole barn pavilion. Now that the FNSB has implemented their budget cuts, we no longer get help from the FNSB at all. So you can see our need to keep the grounds up, with no equipment makes this an impossible task.

The ball field was taken care of nicely so it now has thick grass which a push mower just can't do. It does require a bigger piece of equipment. We researched several different mowers and the John Deere that we picked out is Awesome. It fits best with the intended tasks. It can handle all the area's of the grounds plus do grading of our drive and parking lot, that is in bad repair with lots of pot holes, It can help us to do the front by the highway to keep the place clean and orderly looking. DOT doesn't make it out to Salcha to mow roadways until after the end of the growing season. It can handle a lot of areas of work that we have not been able to do in years past with out having to contract out for big money. We have also included smaller pieces of equipment such as 2 push mowers, 2 weed eaters, shovel's, rakes, hedger's plus a shed to store it all in.


The SFA has the inability to pay for the maintenance to be performed on these grounds. This grant would insure that the SFA will be able to perform maintenance on the designated community grounds and be properly maintained for the safety of community use as intended.

The Salcha Fair Association has greatly appreciated the help and support of the State Legislative Grants in the past. (1) grounds improvements, (2) playground (3) community well upgrade (4) New watering point for community, We are currently almost finished with the community water well and should be up and running by this spring. Note: the water is as good as the spring water at Fox!

We have received several compliments from the community as to the improvements that have been made and future suggestions on what the community would like to see here also. The SFA enjoys providing clean, and safe grounds for the community to use and hope that you can help us once again to provide this service to our community.
