The Crossett Fund will contribute \$10,000 to this project in the form of a matching grant. The City of Kake needs to secure additional funding sources for the remaining project cost.

Detailed Project Description and Justification:

The project began with a Community planning session with Organized Village of Kake, Kake city Schools, City of Kake, Gunnuck Creek Hatchery, Kake Tribal Corporation, with a total of 40 to 50 concerned citizens. The OVK began the project by demolishing the old abandon buildings and gathering vehicles.

The Clean Environment for Healthier Families Demonstration Project goal is to create a project for youth and the community members to continue this work by participating, learning, and understanding that recyclable material can:

- 1) Create a cleaner and healthier environment for Kake families, and
- 2) Extend the life of the landfill.

By establishing a staging area whereby these recallable materials can be picked up and shipped off to be recycled. Presently 300 tons of receyclable material has been gathered and is awaiting pick up by a Ketchikan company, Pool Engeineering. They tried once to pick up the material but the weather was uncooperative, they will try again in the spring. The community will continue to further develop a community program.

This project has been through a public review process. A formal resolutino in support of this project is pending approval from the Kake City Council.
