Project Description/Justification:

The court system received \$500,000 in the FY00 budget, and is requesting \$3,978,000 over three budget years to eliminate the deferred maintenance backlog that has accumulated due to insufficient maintenance funding for state owned facilities. The following project list was in the Legislature's Deferred Maintenance Task Force report as well as HB316/SB228 last session. Those bills did not become law, therefore this request is included this fiscal year in the Capital Improvement Plan.

The projects are prioritized according to the urgency associated with building failure if the repairs are not funded; e.g., roof failure can result in failure of many other structural components. All projects in a location are kept together to reduce costs of the total project.
