**Brief Summary and Statement of Need:**

Any facility having a tank with capacity over 660 gallon, or total combined capacity over 1320 gallons, requires a Spill Prevention Control and Countermeasures (SPCC) plan under the Clean Water Act. These plans require the signature of a licensed engineer, and at a minimum must be reviewed every three years. State and Military facilities are not exempt.
