The GF funding transferred to the Interdepartmental DP Chargeback component is inadequate to provide the level of desktop support needed to meet the department's needs. The contractual costs of maintaining network connectivity to 850+ devices requires I/A authority to meet the billing requirements set by the DOA Information Services Fund. The personal services costs also exceed the GF funding level. Additional I/A receipt authority is needed to provide personal services funding for network and computer support. This funding will pay for a Micro-Computer Technician II position, range 16, and portions of two senior positions: Microcomputer Specialist I, and Microcomputer Specialist II. This group manages major servers and complex network environments for the department, including the systems that deliver state status plats, DNR web servers, the Royalty Accounting database server, GIS database applications, email services, and many other key IT systems the entire department depends upon.
