Project Description/Justification:

This project will construct a 40,527 square foot K-12 facility to replace the 9,898 square foot, 41-year-old elementary school that is in poor condition. The 19-year-old, 9,566 square foot high school will also be surplussed since a renovation/addition option was determined not economically justified. The existing structure was built on the Yukon River flood plain and has been flooded repeatedly, resulting in rot and mildew damage. Additionally, numerous fire code violations exist, including inadequate and improperly designed exits. The school is currently operating at 194% capacity. Proposed cost: \$18,276,430.
