Project Description/Justification:

This project will upgrade both levels of the Hoonah swimming pool, located on the Hoonah High School campus, with a fire sprinkler system to serve the entire 28,064 square foot facility. This will bring it into compliance with fire regulations. If it is not brought into compliance by August 2000, the Division of Fire Prevention may close down the facility. The pool and attached gymnasium are in use throughout the day, often by organized student groups. Proposed cost: \$236,064.
