Project Description/Justification:

This project will provide independent electrical, water, heat, and sewer utilities to 45-year-old, 54,604 square foot Fort Greely Elementary in preparation for closure of the military installation in July 2001. It will also construct a utility building to accommodate those systems. The school will not close when the military leaves; in fact, because the area has been chosen as both a new state prison location and a Strategic Missile Defense System site, enrollment is expected to peak at 90 percent of capacity eight years from now. The school district is currently negotiating with the Department of Defense to take over ownership of the school and its land when base closure occurs. Proposed cost: \$2,037,695.
