**Project Description/Justification:**

This project will complete a 1997 renovation begun by local volunteer labor but never completed. Of primary concern are the roof, which has been patched repeatedly but continues to leak, damaging the interior; the external foundation which was never properly sealed and is beginning to crack; plumbing fixtures and fire cabinets damaged beyond repair by vandalism; and various fire, electrical, and ADA code deficiencies. The 16-year-old structure covers 27,000 square feet and is used as a physical exercise area for students whose only other option would be the 60- to 70-degree below zero Fahrenheit winter outside. Proposed cost: \$989,280.
