Project Description/Justification:

This project will construct a 10,400 square foot K-12 school on DNR land to replace the three modular/trailer units currently in use. The present structures, at 15, 17, and 29 years of age, respectively, cover 2,430 square feet and are operating at 239 percent capacity. In seven years these figures are projected to grow to 309 percent enrollment. Although the condition of all three current units may be classified as poor, one of them will be kept as teacher housing, one will be moved to another school site to relieve overcrowding, and only the oldest, most deteriorated one will be demolished. The project includes installation of a 50 kW generator, a 1,000-gallon fuel tank, and a sprinkler system. Proposed cost: \$3,248,699.
