Additional Information / Prior Funding History:**Project Description/Justification:**

This project will renovate the existing 7,141 square foot high school built primarily in 1980, and construct a 24,200 square foot addition to it. Scammon Bay School is currently operating at 166 percent capacity and is projected to escalate to 210 percent by FY2007. The 6,400 square foot elementary school, primarily built in 1972, will receive abatement of hazardous materials and be surplus. Renovation will eliminate code deficiencies and provide for optimal use of existing space. Proposed cost: \$10,449,769.
