Project Description/Justification:

Innoko River K-12 is 21 years old and covers 14,774 square feet. The existing vocational education shop is a 20 x 50 foot classroom that was salvaged as part of a new construction project in 1987. The building is structurally sound. However, this older classroom has a number of deficiencies that affect the quality of the instructional program. The building does not have running water or bathrooms. The windows are in very poor condition, as is the forced air furnace located in the crawl space in the ceiling. The building does not meet ADA requirements. There is no air evacuation system for the woodworking equipment. There is less than adequate storage for supplies and materials. This project will correct these deficiencies. Proposed cost: \$75,328.
