Additional Information / Prior Funding History:**Project Description/Justification:**

This project will test and inspect fuel tanks and pipes at Whittier with a view to tank replacement; a bio-remediation project may also be required because of past fuel spills. In Tatitlek, the project will install a security fence around the tank farm and apply a concrete slurry to an adjacent rock wall to prevent tank rupture from rockslides. In Chenega Bay, it will reconstruct a support structure for a 1,200-gallon tank and install a containment barrier. All three fuel facilities lie within a quarter mile of the navigable waters of Prince William Sound. Proposed cost: \$232,288.
