Project Description/Justification:

This project will replace one of the school's two auxiliary generators with a 75-KW generator, install an automatic actuator, and provide hookup to the separate Vocational Education building which has no auxiliary source of electricity. The exact age of the generator needing replacement is unknown, but it was taken from the old BIA school and is estimated to exceed 30 years of age. The school building itself is 15 years old and covers 10,200 square feet. The existing generator has a history of mechanical failure and finding parts for it is difficult. Erratic flow and extended failures of village power necessitate a reliable backup source to protect the school's electrical devices and sprinkler system. Proposed cost: \$201,145.

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
