In FY2000, funding for this project was requested, however, it was not approved by the legislature.

Project Description/Justification:

BIA School Site Cleanup

In the late 1970's and early 1980's, the State of Alaska accepted ownership of schools and school related facilities from the U.S. Bureau of Indian Affairs (BIA) or the U.S. Bureau of Land Management (BLM) on behalf of the BIA.

Over the past two decades, some of these facilities have been replaced and are no longer used as schools. As a consequence of their abandonment, they are gradually deteriorating and offering increasing health and safety hazards to village residents.

The Department of Education & Early Development proposes to begin a directed, phased program of site remediation and cleanup at former BIA school properties.

This initial proposal would address Grayling and Nightmute with future funding addressing other BIA sites.

The projects will include:

Asbestos abatement, removal and disposal of other hazardous material, demolition of the facility, removal of pilings.

The budget also includes \$25,000 for site evaluation, work scope delineation and estimate preparation at two of the remaining former BIA sites. The final determination of the site will follow evaluation of a site survey to be sent to districts in the spring of 1999.
