**Additional Information / Prior Funding History:**

This project has been requested on an annual basis and has consistently been used to correct minor deficiencies and solve problems created by unforeseen circumstances for both the Airport and leaseholders.

**Project Description/Justification:**

The Airport has an ongoing need to react quickly to make needed repairs or improvements not listed in the annual capital budget. The projects are often needed to meet changed conditions created by airline operations or FAA requirements. Projects occur primarily in the airfield and terminal areas. Despite inflation, the Annual Improvements funding amount has not increased in over 10 years.
