Project Description/Justification:

EPA and ADEC have adopted clean air, clean water, and hazardous substance compliance standards, which must be met within a mandated time frame. This project will allow the airport to properly evaluate current hazardous substance problems, prepare necessary mitigation plans, start and continue the environmental cleanup, and initiate proactive plans to prevent future contamination.

Projects funded in the past, underway, or planned include: underground storage tank assessment, removal and replacement; contaminated sites evaluation, remediation and monitoring; free product recovery; fuel hydrant system evaluation; closure of old fire pits; environmental risk assessment and development of contaminated soils remediation area.
