Project Description/Justification:

FAI capital project contracts have for several years incorporated the extraction of gravel from a material source site located close to the northern end of the existing float pond. The footprint of the site, the slopes of the banks, and the depth have been controlled specifically to allow for the new area to serve as an extension of the float pond for additional parking slips for float equipped aircraft.

FAI's existing floatplane facility has a waiting list availability period of two years. The airport has been fortunate to acquire, through other project contracts, a 14-acre body of water, that itself has been constructed to float pond standards, at no cost. Completion of this project will enable the airport to satisfy virtually the entire waiting list and to keep the waiting period for new applicants at a minimum for the foreseeable future.
