This project reconditions and paves 1.5 miles of Exit Glacier road and loop parking area within Kenai Fjords National Park, and in doing so, provides flood control, endangered plant species protection and improved visitor satisfaction and safety. Also included in the project is a newly constructed restroom facility in the parking area(s), complete with running water, septic and power, appropriately sized for the projected demand. All compliance for road improvements is complete. The park is currently working on compliance documents for the water and septic system installation.
