The Norton Sound Health Corporation (NSHC) has requested that the funds for the food safety and sanitation work be transferred back to the Department of Environmental Conservation (DEC), Food Safety and Sanitation Program (FSS). Though currently administered by NSHC, this program was previously administered by the State DEC. This is a net zero transfer and does not cost additional general funds. Responsibilities encompass a comprehensive food safety and sanitation effort including inspections, training, facility plan reviews, waiver issuance and investigations of food and water borne illnesses. The program also includes enforcement responsibilities, but NSHC does not have the authority to do enforcement of the program. The State Department of Environmental Conservation with its existing infrastructure has the better capability to cover the spectrum of responsibilities.

To become "certified," operators must meet a combination of education and experience requirements and pass an examination. Recent changes in federal law lower the threshold for mandatory operator certification from systems serving more than 500 people to systems serving 25 people or more. Operators of approximately 650 small public drinking water systems in Alaska will need to be trained and certified to comply with federal law.</p> <p>A working group developed regulations for small system operator certification and training. The approach adopted would deliver training and administer examinations to the vast majority of these small system operators on-site. Federal grant funds are available to pay for the training and certification costs. A capital budget appropriation would be used to contract with an entity to visit each facility, provide on-site training, administer an examination, and issue a certificate. It would also provide additional funding to increase existing RMW contracts to cover increasing costs of providing the service due primarily to increasing travel costs.</p> <p>The Remote Maintenance Worker (RMW) program provides over-the-shoulder and emergency assistance to water and sewerage system operators in over 170 remote communities. Work is primarily accomplished through contracts with Regional Health Corporations. A total of 15 Remote Maintenance Workers are stationed in Sitka, Anchorage, Dillingham, Bethel, St. Mary's, Holy Cross, Nome, Kotzebue and Fairbanks. From these hubs, each is responsible for traveling to and assisting approximately 10 remote communities. Since establishing the program, sanitation system operator training and certification levels have improved dramatically, and there have been no catastrophic losses of sanitation systems due to operational problems in rural Alaska. The program currently covers all parts of the State with the exception of the Alaska Peninsula, Aleutian Islands and Pribilof Islands.</p> <p>This exclusively federally-funded increment will expand the current RMW program by establishing a single Remote Maintenance Worker to assist Aleutian and Pribilof Island communities. It would also provide approximately \$200.0 to be allocated between the six Regional Health Corporations to cover increased travel and personal services costs.</p>
