Brief Summary and Statement of Need:

Any facility having a fuel tank with over a 660 gallon capacity, or total combined capacity over 1320 gallons, requires a Spill Prevention Control and Countermeasures (SPCC) plan under the Clean Water Act. These plans require the signature of a licensed engineer, and at a minimum must be reviewed every three years. State and Military Facilities are not exempt.

Additional Information / Prior Funding History:

Audit of federal records show that federal funds were being expended on state requirements. These funds are required to pay for the state portion of the costs.

Project Description/Justification:

The Federal Clean Water Act requires the revision and update of the SPCC plan every three years. Funds will pay for the preparation and revision of these plans for facilities in proportion to cost sharing responsibilities. Noncompliance can lead to a \$10,000 per day fine.

Specific Spending Detail:

State will pay its portion (13%) of the SPCC plan requirement. Planned sites are attached with cost estimates.
