Project Description/Justification:

Airfield Pavement Maintenance, Electric & Blast

Rehabilitate the runways, taxiways and aprons located on the airfield in accordance with the Pavement Maintenance and Management Plan (PMMP).

Associated improvements to be accomplished under this project include

- electrical systems and lighting (such as replacement and upgrades of wiring, transformers, centerline/edge lights, conduit, ducts, wire, electrical vaults, and associated electric systems);
- blast protection pavements, safety areas, relocation/replacement of airfield signage, crack sealing, realigning taxiways and aircraft parking, fillet widening, pavement reconstruction, fuel hydrants, drainage improvements, and loading bridge replacement at the North Terminal;
- pavement inspection testing and analysis, mapping and purchasing of pavement testing support equipment.
