**Brief Summary and Statement of Need:**

Road resurfacing, rut repair, and road resurface and transfer program within the Anchorage Metropolitan Area. This program is for state roads only. The State owns and maintains many roads that would in other states be the responsibility of the metropolitan area or county. The State is prohibited from selecting projects except on the National Highway System. This program will encourage the Anchorage Metropolitan Planning Organization (AMATS) to select projects on state roads by providing funds for that purpose. This program may also be aimed at improving state roads for ownership transfer to the Municipality of Anchorage.
