Possible level of earmarked federal funds for Alaska in preliminary committee reports in Congress. If the State is expected to match all of these earmarks, it will cost over \$14 million, which we have not included in the Federal-Aid Highway State Match request. Many of the earmark projects are local priorities. The non-federal share for federal-aid highway projects ranges from 0% to 50%. This project contributes to the Department's Mission by improving the mobility of people and goods and by increasing private investment.
