Project Description/Justification:

The Kotzebue Airport Master Plan update was completed in 1998. Kotzebue is a busy primary airport with over 52,000 annual enplanements. There are minimal airport lease lots left at Kotzebue, and long-term expansion potential is limited by topographic constraints. Studying potential airport relocation to meet long-term growth projections is necessary.
