**Additional Information / Prior Funding History:**

The deferred maintenance for harbors exceeds \$40 million. FY 2004 \$0; FY2003 - \$700,000; FY2002 - \$600,000; FY2001 - \$600,000; FY2000 - \$600,000; FY1999 - \$900,000. This is an annual capital request to address the most critical deferred maintenance issues.

**Project Description/Justification:**

After transferring the Harbors approved in the HB525 bond issue, the State owned harbors deferred maintenance backlog is still over \$15 million for approximately 44 facilities around Alaska that will remain a primary State responsibility. This request is to address the most critical of these facilities such as Port Alexander (estimated at \$607,400), Angoon (estimated at \$85,300), Kasaan (estimated at \$38,400), Elfin Cove (estimated at \$120,900) and other small repairs and renovations necessary to maintain safe and functional harbor facilities.
